To apply, immediate family members (a representative if no immediate family exists) will need to bring the following to MCHS and complete an application, Mon-Fri, 8 to 5pm. Other documents may be required if needed to make a determination. Applicants may also apply and upload documents online at minnehahacounty.gov.

For the family members (spouse, adult children, adult siblings, grandparents): \Diamond Proof of income (paystubs, income tax return, employer statement) \(\rightarrow \) Bank statements These documents will assist caseworker in determining family's ability to pay or make payments.

Other Information:

- Financial help will be a loan from the County and a lien will be placed on the estate and on certain family members responsible for the deceased individual.
- The County has a cemetery that may be utilized if assistance is approved. If so, there is no cost.
- Any County assistance must be pre-authorized.
- When the County provides assistance, the funeral home cannot charge the family the difference. Payment by the County is considered to be "in full".
- A final decision will be made within five business days after requested documents are returned to MCHS.
